

Attire Requirements

1. Girls Combination Class attire ages 2 ½ - 7 : Any color leotard and tights, pink ballet shoes and black tap shoes.
2. Girls Combination Class attire ages 8 and up: Solid color leotard and pink or new tights, pink ballet shoes, black jazz shoes and black tap shoes.
3. All girls hair pulled neatly away from face in bun or French braid.
4. Boys class attire: Black dance pants and white shirt, black ballet shoes and black tap shoes.
5. Hip Hop attire: Jazz pants/leggings and leotard or fitted athletic tank, black jazz shoes.

☺ Cover ups may be worn for warming only.

**Here is an example of how the elastics in youth tap shoes should look like:
